The month was warm and dry, as seems to be the new norm. The shorebirding at Fern Ridge Reservoir continued to be quite good with the ODF&W staff pumping water into the ponds to keep them from drying up during migration— thanks again Wayne Morrow and staff! As is normal for the month, most of the neotropical migrants have left for their wintering grounds and a number of the northern breeders have arrived for the winter.

<b>Stilt Sandpiper</b>	Sept 2	FRR	RR	Last report for the fall season.
<b>Short-billed Dowitcher (2)</b>	Sept 23	FRR	NS	Getting late for this species.

<b>Red-necked Phalarope</b>	Sept 2	FRR	RR	About the end of their southward migration.
<b>Red-necked Phalarope</b>	Sept 2	SJSR – dog pond	WH	About the end of their southward migration.
<b>Common Tern (15-20)</b>	Sept 9	Heceta Beach	DP	Seen in small numbers this time of year.
<b>Common Tern (2)</b>	Sept 23	FRR	NS	Normally found during the fall at this location.
