January was much dryer than usual. What caused some of the earliest spring migrants (swallows and Say's Phoebe) to show up during the month? We don't know. You would think that warmer weather would be more important than dryer weather in triggering movement. Then again, the Say's Phoebe may be a bird that's trying to winter here; there was a report from the same location in early November as well.
