- UNCOMMON:** Regularly found in proper habitat in small to moderate numbers.
- RARE:** Annual or nearly annual, can be irregular or irruptive, not easily found.
- OCCASIONAL:** Unexpected vagrants or extraordinary out-of-season occurrence.
