- We will spend roughly one hour with you while we walk around your yard, take notes, and chat with you about your goals for your yard.
- We will explain the certification process and answer questions.
- We will send you a report within two weeks of the site visit with recommendations and actions you may take.
- We make follow up phone calls at 2 and 4 months and will provide a certification visit at your request. There is no deadline for certification. Work at your own pace.
- You will receive an “In progress” lawn sign upon enrollment and a durable, metal certification sign when certified.
- You will receive a packet with information and resources in the community to complete your goals. This includes a card for discounted prices at our local native plant nurseries, either Doak Creek or Trillium Nursery. You also receive 10% off of bulk purchases at Lane Forest Products.
